NNI's 5-K Run/Walk is set for July 30

A.B.O.P.T., NNI's annual collection of antifreeze, batteries, oil, paint, and tires, and other pesky stuff, will happen on Saturday, May 21, from 8 a.m. until noon at 701 NW Barry Road (across Barry Road behind Best Buy and Children's Mercy Hospital). Last year's event drew more than 600 area residents who disposed of that hard-to-get-rid-of stuff in a safe, responsible way. That resulted in the biggest household hazardous

waste clean-up in the history of Kansas City. The NNI staff is planning and coordinating the massive collection along with environmental specialists from the City of Kansas City, Missouri. They will be assisted by Kansas City Police officers and volunteers. New this year: Big Brothers and Big Sisters will accept used items and Habitat Restore Store will have a truck there to collect construction materials.
