Is your home still on a septic tank? NNI may have good news for you!

Through a partnership with the Kansas City Water Services Department, NNI is ready and able to help Kansas City residents get long-awaited sanitary sewer connections...at substantial cost savings.

Why should you connect to the sanitary sewer system?

If your property is near a sanitary sewer main, you may be required to connect to the main if your septic tank ever needs replacement. There are also important health and environmental benefits and it may increase your home's value.

How much will it cost?

The cost will vary depending on your household income, but for some households, the cost could be \$0 (Yes, zero!).

Why now? My septic system is working fine.

Grant funds are available to assist qualified households, **but for a limited time only**. When the grant funds are gone, the homeowner will be responsible for the full expense.

How do I know whether I qualify?

Finding out whether you qualify is free, easy and confidential. Just call **Cheryl, 816-454-2000**, at NNI. She will answer your questions and, when your application is approved, get a qualified contractor on the job.

Remember:

Your property must be in Kansas City, Missouri, have access to a sanitary sewer main, and you must meet income guidelines. Call today!
