Today, two good friends of NNI have announcements that can help with your spring lawn makeover. Tonya Davis, KCMO Sustainability Manager, is an active member of our Neighborhood Relations Committee, and Richard King, Gladstone's Public Information Coordinator, ably chairs the committee.

For Kansas City Residents: The leaf and brush drop-off site at 1815 N. Chouteau Trafficway, is open for the season, with expanded hours and new products! Open Wednesday through Saturday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Colored mulch, chipwood, topsoil, and garden mixes available in bulk or by the bag. Fees are charged, but Saturday disposal for KC residents is free, with reduced rates for alternative days. The site is open to all Northland residents and businesses. The Chouteau site provides helpful services to Northland residents and, at the same time, helps the environment. The dropped off waste is transformed into usable products. Just think, the leaves you dropped off last year may very well be the compost you add to your garden this year. --Tonya Davis

For Gladstone Residents: Gladstone residents can drop off brush, leaf and other yard waste from May 4 through May 6, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily. The drop-off site is the Gladstone public works facility, 4000 NE 76th Street. Proof of residency may be required. **--Richard King**
