NNI presents candidate slate for Annual Meeting

Each year, NNI Member organizations elect persons to the NNI Board of Directors. Candidates for the Board complete applications and participate in a candidate forum held each May, one month prior to the Annual Meeting. The NNI Board then selects a slate to present to the Members for election. The 2012-2013 slate:

Open Seats

J. C. Sanders is running for an open seat created by the departure of Dan Fowler, who served 2 full terms on the NNI Board.

Jessica Luedke is running for an open seat created by the departure of Tom Schweitzer, who served 2 full terms on the NNI Board.

Board members may serve two consecutive 3-year terms.

Second Term

Dave Dunlop, having served one term on the Board, is running for a second 3-year term.

Richard King, having served out the term of a resigning Board member, is running for a second 3-year term.

Dennis Tedford, having served one term on the Board, is running for a second 3-year term.

First Full Term

Darren Hennen, originally appointed in 2011 to serve out the term of a resigning Board member, is running for his first full term.

Special thanks to retiring Board President Dan Fowler and retiring Vice President (and former Treasurer) Tom Schweitzer for their long and distinguished service on the NNI Board. The NNI Board sets a high standard for non-profit governance. (Attendance at board meetings consistently runs near 90%.) In addition to attendance at regular Board meetings, each member serves on at least one of NNI's standing committees: Executive, Administration and Finance, Governmental Affairs, Neighborhood Relations, and Resource Development.
