Home Repair Applications Available

NNI is now accepting applications for The Chouteau Housing Assistance and Maintenance Program (CHAMP). This is a targeted minor home repair program for the Chaumiere and Winnwood-Sunnybrook neighborhoods, and incorporates the North Jackson Neighborhood Action Plan. This grant is for exterior repairs which generally include roofs, siding, windows, HVAC, concrete work, etc. Eligible applicants are single-family homeowners who must maintain residency for five years after the repair work from the grant is complete.
