

Kansas City's mayoral and council elections are this year. The next election is the Municipal, School & Special Election on April 2nd, 2019. The last day to register to vote in the upcoming election is March 6th, 2019.

The Fiscal Year 2019-20 Budget will be submitted on February, 14th and will be adopted on March 21st. Prior to adoption, the City will hold Budget hearings on February, 19th, February 21st, February, 23rd, and March 2nd.

At the hearings, you will have the opportunity to hear from the Mayor, the Mayor Pro Tem, and the City Council, and will also receive an overview of the submitted document from the Budget Office. All attendees will have the opportunity to speak directly to the council and the general public about their concerns regarding the budget.

In March 2018 the Beyond the Loop Planning and Environmental Linkage (PEL) study was completed. Since then the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) and the City of Kansas City Missouri have launched an environmental assessment that is estimated to be completed in the fall of 2019.

The environmental assessment builds on the PEL study to look into options to improve or potentially replace the bridge.
