Programs are provided on timely subjects to help seniors stay healthy, safe, and informed.

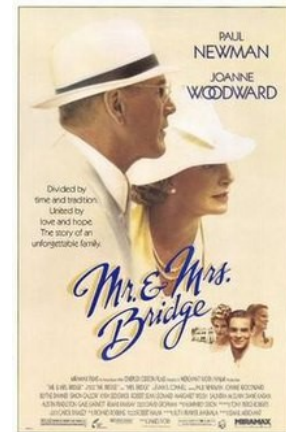
Every other month, a movie is shown on NNI's 85-inch screen.

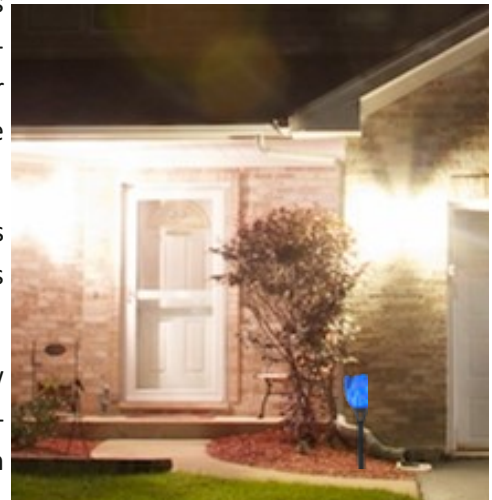
NNI Project Blue Light
