

After many years of witnessing the abandonment and decline of the Kmart site on NE Vivion Road; the long awaited day finally arrived. Twenty-nine residents, representing neighborhoods and businesses, gathered at NNI's Focus Vivion Road Committee on September 21, to begin the planning process for the redevelopment of this site.

The Kansas City Area Transportation Authority purchased the property in May of 2022, with a goal of creating a Transit Oriented Development (TOD). A TOD is a type of development that maximizes the amount of residential, business, and leisure space with walking distance of public transportation. Possibilities discussed at the September meeting included, housing, retail, a childcare facility, and green space. Addressing the challenges of storm drainage and increased traffic were stated priorities.

The planning process is anticipated to be completed by the end of the year.


